Chapter references are where the term first appears in the novel.
(Some terms may contain slight spoilers.)

A

Aarian - (Chapter 4) He was the freelance captain of a space freighter ship named *Aarian's Freighter*. Aarian had gray hair.

Aarian's Freighter - (Chapter 4) A space freighter ship owned by a freelance captain named Aarian.

Abbitarr - (Chapter 10) A Third Tiffan Siram Empire battleship under the leadership of Captain Ertlees. The *Abbitarr* was destroyed when the captain attacked a gas mining asteroid in the Ythorn Asteroid Mass, which caused an extremely large explosion.

Adarr - (Chapter 6) He was the business partner of Aarian on *Aarian's Freighter* until his death.

Age of the Masses - (Chapter 2) It was a reference to a time when all the clans on the planet Raatoris had many disputes.

Age of the Tyrants - (Chapter 3) It was a time during the First Tiffan Siram Empire when the House of Axe was in power. They were tyrants to the citizens of the galaxy for approximately 690 years, from the year 7920 to the year 8610. Their reign ended when the last ruler, Empress Priscilla Axe transitioned the governance to the Second Republic. She was the first president of the Second Republic.

Almonis Tarque - (Chapter 8) A planet that was the seat of the Thraxian Government.

Almoss - (Chapter 3) An old-fashioned town on the planet Myrath.

Alnor - (Chapter 1) A planet located in the Telneth Star System. Alnor was destroyed during the Telfire Wars. It was located within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Ameriss - (Chapter 10) She was a Thraxian who lived in the city of Shenix Falls on the planet Almonis Tarque. Ameriss had white hair. She was good friends with Shanda Rubine.

Amminar - (Chapter 5) He was a Galactic Government official who betrayed the leader, Straton Arnious and his other dignitaries and advisors. Amminar poisoned them to help Boris Anathor become emperor and restore the government name as the Third Tiffan Siram Empire.

Amonis Clan - (Chapter 2) One of the Notable Clans on the planet Raatoris.

Amonith - (Chapter 7) He was a shuttle pilot who lived on the planet Obrah.

Amveries - (Chapter 10) A planet that was greatly affected by the Tiffan Siram Galactic War. Amveries was located within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Anathor, Emperor Boris - (Chapter 5) He was the emperor of the Third Tiffan Siram Empire after a hostile takeover of the Galactic Government and its leader, Straton Arnious.

Ancient Prophets - (Chapter 8) A poem by Remyw Yort.

Ancient Raatoris - (Chapter 2) A period of time on the planet Raatoris when it was controlled by the Scyllian Clan.

Anti-gravitational Transport (AGT) - (Chapter 4) An anti-gravitational land craft.

Archineel - (Chapter 2) It was the official language of the First Tiffan Siram Empire, after it had been changed from Nesbeoch. Archineel was used in communications between most of the planets of the galaxy. The origin of Archineel was from the old, destroyed planet Seelious, which was destroyed when a drifting satellite collided into it.

Arnious, Straton - (Chapter 2) He lived on the planet Ishtorb. Straton was the fourth leader of the Galactic Government after the implementation of the New Galactic Order. He had black and gray hair.

Aslat, Shane - (Chapter 1) He was from the planet Elbi, which was destroyed during the Telfire Wars. Shane's parents were killed there. During the evacuation, he was separated from his brother. Shane was one point eight meters tall. He had green eyes and long, brown hair. Shane's left ear was pierced. His girlfriend was Shanda Rubine. Shane acquired a spaceship named *Star Crystal*.

Auranaxis - (Chapter 8) He was a Thraxian who lived on the planet Almonis Tarque. Auranaxis was an officer in the Thraxian military during the Tiffan Siram Galactic War. He was bald on top of his head and had long, white hair in the back. Auranaxis was the father of a young Thraxian boy. He also had a dog named Teraster. Auranaxis befriended Shane Aslat and Shanda Rubine while searching for the treasure.

Axithorp - (Chapter 7) Large, green creatures with sharp teeth that looked more fierce than they actually were.

B

Bartu - (Chapter 1) A planet located in the Telneth Star System. Bartu was destroyed during the Telfire Wars. It was located within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Bassin, Moro - (Chapter 7) He was a star crystal miner and later an inventory control specialist. Moro had gray hair. He owned a spaceship named *Star Crystal*.

Bathannia's World - (Chapter 1) A remote planet known for its intoxication joints and gambling facilities. Bathannia's World was located

within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Both - (Chapter 10) He was an officer in the Third Tiffan Siram Empire military. Both was the lead officer of the *Abbitarr*.

C

Calazen - (Chapter 10) He was a Devrakian representative to the Thraxian Government.

D

Delbis Salias - (Chapter 10) A planet that was located outside of the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Desinarr - (Chapter 10) He was a Thraxian who lived on the planet Almonis Tarque. Desinarr was the Thraxian Government administrator. He had white hair.

Devrakian - (Chapter 10) A short species with gray skin and large red eyes. A series of small ripples covered their bald heads. Devrakians spoke with reverberating tones.

Duelthine, Saadi - (Chapter 2) He was from the Nesb Clan on the planet Raatoris. Saadi became the first emperor of the First Tiffan Siram Empire. He was responsible for seating the imperial throne on the planet Sulluth.

E

Early First Tiffan Siram Empire - (Chapter 2) The time period when the First Tiffan Siram Empire was occupied by the Notable Clans, from the year 7109 to the year 7291.

Elbi - (Chapter 1) A planet located in the Telneth Star System. Elbi was destroyed during the Telfire Wars. It was located within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Emperor Boris Anathor - (*See Anathor, Emperor Boris*)

Emperor Semadian Tymor - (See Tymor, Emperor Semadian)

Emperor Tulli - (Chapter 3) He was the emperor of the Tulli Realm with territory around the town of Almass on the planet Myrath. Emperor Tulli was a warrior who conquered the small village during the early colonization of Myrath. He resided in the Tulli Castle on Mount Amor, which overlooked the town of Almass. Emperor Tulli had gray hair. He kept a harem of women in the Tulli Castle for his pleasure.

Era of the Thraxians - (Chapter 8) It was a time during the First Tiffan Siram Empire when the House of Tesserane was in power. Era of the Thraxians was the first and only time a non-human race was in power in the imperium. The Thraxians ruled for approximately 2203 years, from the year 11005 to the year 13208. Eventually, the humans forced the Thraxians to step down and a period of interregnum followed.

Ertlees, Captain - (Chapter 10) He was an officer in the Third Tiffan Siram Empire military. Ertlees was the captain of the *Abbitarr*.

Expeditionary Journals - (Chapter 8) A series of journals from a well known galactic traveler named Vincent Ryineos.

F

Feenith - (Chapter 1) An old city on the planet Selnaan.

First Tiffan Siram Empire - (Chapter 1) A galactic empire that was founded in the year 7109 by the Notable Clans of Raatoris. The duration of First Tiffan Siram Empire was approximately 6100 years; however, there were interruptions many times with interregnums and multiple republics. It ended with the Galactic Revolution. The seat of the First Tiffan Siram Empire was originally on the planet Raatoris, but later moved to the planet Sulluth.

Futuristic Dreams - (Chapter 8) A poem by the legendary poet Remyw Yort.

G

Galactic Economics Exchange Council (GEEC) - (Chapter 5) An organization established in the year 14831 by Emperor Semadian Tymor during the Second Tiffan Siram Empire. The Galactic Economics Exchange Council was founded to help the galactic economy, but many years later, under the New Galactic Order, the system was filled with corruption and a tool for control through digital currency.

Galactic Government - (Chapter 1) A government formed in the year 15000 by a group of people from the New Galactic Order. The Galactic Government was a controversial government with much overreach and a tyrannical, dystopian control. Its jurisdiction was a vast portion of the Tiffan Siram Galaxy, but not the entire galaxy. The seat of the Galactic Government was on the planet Ishtorb.

Galactic Government Troops - (Chapter 1) Galactic Government military officers.

Galaxy's High Degree of Wanted Criminals - (Chapter 7) A television program that featured the galaxy's supposed high degree of wanted criminals in the hopes that the citizens of the galaxy watching the program would help in their capture. Unfortunately, the dystopian government included non-criminals who dissented from the government's political views.

H

House of Tesserane - (Chapter 8) A family of Thraxians who ruled during the First Tiffan Siram Empire. It was known as the Era of the Thraxians with nine different emperors over 2203 years.

House of Tymor - (Chapter 5) A family who ruled during the Second Tiffan Siram Empire with eleven different emperors over 284 years.

I

Imperial Throne - (Chapter 2) A reference to the seat of government in any of the Tiffan Siram Empires.

Ineffective Life - (Chapter 8) A poem by Remyw Yort.

intoxication joint - (Chapter 1) A drinking establishment.

Ironclad - (Chapter 8) He was the captain of the sail ship *Maritime Maiden*.

Ishtorb - (Chapter 2) A planet that was the seat of the Galactic Government and the Third Tiffan Siram Empire.

K

Kelv Wesnith Synod - (Chapter 3) A synod that came to exist in the year 8217, during the Age of the Tyrants. The Kelv Wesnith Synod assembled together on the planet Troth to draft and create an acknowledgment of faith in the one true religion.

Kelv Wesnith Synod Acknowledgment of Faith - (Chapter 3) An acknowledgment of faith drafted by the Kelv Wesnith Synod in the year 8217.

L

Leenith - (Chapter 6) He was the assistant minister for the main Universal Expanse Church on the planet Troth.

Life's Sorrow - (Chapter 8) A poem by Remyw Yort.

lightspeed-plus - (Chapter 1) A general term used to reference spaceship speeds beyond that of light.

Lost Scroll, The - (Chapter 1) It was a reference to The Stolen Scroll that had been passed down through the generations of the Naith family and had become lost. The search for The Lost Scroll was minimal.

Lysith Palace - (Chapter 10) A tall building in the great city of Shenix Falls on the planet Almonis Tarque that was the seat of the Thraxian Government. The Lysith Palace was an enormous structure with many towers and spires extending into the sky, including landing platforms extending out from the towers.

M

Maritime Maiden - (Chapter 8) An old sail ship owned by a captain named Ironclad. *Maritime Maiden's* homeport was the town of Thisilia on the Slave Sea of the planet Myrath.

Metrocity - (Chapter 1) A city on the planet Yaraden.

Misque Shores - (Chapter 7) A city on the planet Obrah.

Mount Amor - (Chapter 3) A mountain near the town of Almass on the planet Myrath.

Morrison - (Chapter 8) He lived in the port town of Thisilia on the planet Myrath. Morrison had gray hair. He ran a horse stable business in Thisilia.

Myrath - (Chapter 3) An antiquated planet located outside of the Galactic Government's jurisdiction.

N

Naith, Allio - (Chapter 2) He was an engineer on the planet Onorra. Allio was known for finding the Stolen Scroll.

Namaas Forest - (Chapter 1) A vast forest that covered one third of the planet Raatoris.

Nesb Clan - (Chapter 2) One of the Notable Clans on the planet Raatoris.

Nesbeoch - (Chapter 2) The language of the Nesb Clan. Nesbeoch became the official language of the planet Raatoris.

New Galactic Order - (Chapter 2) A federation of planets controlled by the Galactic Government with its authoritarian power and control.

Norba - (Chapter 3) He was an aide for Emperor Tulli.

Notable Clans - (Chapter 2) A group of clans from the planet Raatoris that came together and founded the First Tiffan Siram Empire, which put an

end to the Age of the Masses. The Notable Clans included the Nesb Clan, the Amonis Clan, the Rhen Clan, and the Thesila Clan.

Nottoran, Commander - (Chapter 10) He was a Thraxian commander in the Thraxian military. Nottoran's regiment fought on the planet Amveries during the Tiffan Siram Galactic War. He had white hair.

O

Obrah - (Chapter 4) A planet located on the border and within the Galactic Government's jurisdiction.

Ojenis Temples - (Chapter 1) They were temples located in the Namaas Forest on the planet Raatoris. The Ojenis Temples were built by the Scyllian Clan to preserve a majestic treasure they had discovered in the Namaas Forest.

Onorra - (Chapter 2) A planet where Allio Naith worked as an engineer. Onorra was located within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

P

Piross - (Chapter 2) He was an undercover agent for the Galactic Government. Piross was bald.

Pondu Norax VII - (Chapter 3) A planet located outside of the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Port Fae - (Chapter 8) A port town on the Slave Sea on the planet Myrath.

R

Raatoris - (Chapter 1) A planet that had approximately one third of its surface covered by the Namaas Forest. The First Tiffan Siram Empire was founded on Raatoris and was the original seat of the empire. The Imperial Throne was later moved to the planet Sulluth by the first emperor. Toward the end of the First Tiffan Siram Empire, before the Galactic Revolution, Raatoris was set aside as a memorial planet and abandoned. Although

Raatoris was within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction, the planet eventually had been forgotten.

Raatoris Conference - (Chapter 2) A conference that was held in the year 7108 on the planet Raatoris by a group of noble people from each of the clans on that planet. The group, known as the Notable Clans, made many important decisions during the conference, including making their official language Nesbeoch and to form the First Tiffan Siram Empire.

Reigning On You (Return of Thee) - (Chapter 8) A poem by Remyw Yort.

Renlin, Pastor - (Chapter 10) He was a Thraxian pastor who lived on the planet Almonis Tarque. Pastor Renlin had white hair.

Resofain Clan - (Chapter 2) A clan on the planet Raatoris. The Resofain Clan existed after the Scyllian Clan and before the Notable Clans. They were known for their discovery of a scroll left behind by the Scyllian Clan. The Resofain Clan put the scroll into a Resofain museum.

Rhen Clan - (Chapter 2) One of the Notable Clans on the planet Raatoris.

Romison, Harris - (Chapter 8) He was a famous wise man. Harris wrote the *Wisdom Chronicles*.

Rubine, Shanda - (Chapter 1) She was originally from the planet Pondu Norax VII. Shanda lived in the town of Almass on the planet Myrath. She had long, blond hair. Shanda's boyfriend was Shane Aslat. She was best friends with Troi.

Ryineos, Vincent - (Chapter 8) He was a galactic traveler known for his *Expeditionary Journals*.

Rytoorian Asteroid Mass - (Chapter 7) A group of asteroids where a star crystal mining operation was located.

S

Sands of Time, The - (Chapter 8) A poem by Remyw Yort.

Scyllian Clan - (Chapter 1) One of the first known clans on Ancient Raatoris in the year 4863. The Scyllian Clan had discovered a majestic treasure in the Namaas Forest in the year 5181 and build the Ojenis Temples in the forest to preserve it in. The clan mysteriously disappeared from the planet in the year 5612, but left behind evidence of the treasure and the Ojenis Temples, including a scroll. After their disappearance, there were still people on Raatoris, however, none of them were yet organized into other clans yet.

Second Tiffan Siram Empire - (Chapter 2) A galactic empire that was founded in the year 13926 by the House of Northtower. The duration of Second Tiffan Siram Empire was approximately 1069 years. It ended with an interregnum just before the New Galactic Order and the formation of the Galactic Government. The seat of the Second Tiffan Siram Empire was on the planet Sulluth.

Seelious - (Chapter 2) A planet that was destroyed when a drifting satellite collided into it. Seelious was the origin of the main language in the Tiffan Siram Galaxy.

Selnaan - (Chapter 1) A planet where an annual historic art festival was held. Selnaan was located within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Shallum Ibner - (Chapter 1) A planet located in the Telneth Star System. Shallum Ibner was destroyed during the Telfire Wars. It was located within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Shenix Falls - (Chapter 10) A city on the planet Almonis Tarque where the seat of the Thraxian Government was located.

Shenix Falls Medical Facility - (Chapter 10) A hospital in the city of Shenix Falls on the planet Almonis Tarque.

Sheth - (Chapter 1) Many orphans were relocated to Sheth during the Telfire Wars. Sheth was located within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Slave Sea - (Chapter 3) A large sea on the planet Myrath.

SR Series Robot - (Chapter 4) Robots that had been manufactured on the planet Yaraden.

star crystal (mineral) - (Chapter 7) A valuable mineral that was mined in certain asteroids.

Star Crystal (spaceship) - (Chapter 7) A spaceship initially owned by Moro Bassin. Moro gave the *Star Crystal* to Shane Aslat.

Stolen Scroll, The - (Chapter 2) It was a reference to the scroll that had been stolen from a Resofain museum. The Stolen Scroll was found on another planet in the year 6946 by Allio Naith. The scroll itself told the story of a majestic treasure discovered by the Scyllian Clan of Raatoris and the Ojenis Temples they had built to preserve the treasure in.

Stoughe, Adrex - (Chapter 3) He was a Universal Expansionist. In 8360, Adrex Stoughe composed the *Stoughe Creed*. He died a martyr.

Stoughe Creed - (Chapter 3) It was composed by Adrex Stoughe in the year 8360. The *Stoughe Creed* was a summary of the *Kelv Wesnith Synod Acknowledgment of Faith*. The creed consisted of five elements of canon law: the Creator made everything, the Creator has the power to perform anything that He wishes, He is in control of everything at all times, He is the All-seeing Eye, and His spiritual creatures should love Him and each other and be wise unto death.

Sulluth - (Chapter 2) A planet that became the seat of the First and Second Tiffan Siram Empires. The first emperor of the imperium, Saadi Dueltine, was responsible for moving the Imperial Throne from Raatoris to Sulluth. However, the seat of the Third Tiffan Siram Empire was located on the planet Ishtorb.

Sypron Swamp - (Chapter 9) A swamp on the planet Toris, formerly named Raatoris.

T

Tarofain - (Chapter 6) A species known for their extreme height of approximately three meters tall.

Telfire Wars - (Chapter 1) A series of wars that erupted in the Telneth Star System in the year 15073 when the people demanded that the system's space freight monopoly be broken up. The conflict was originally between the original freight company and new freight companies that had formed. Eventually, the conflict shifted to the freight companies against people hauling their own freight. With the companies firing weapons at the civilians and rampant revenge, the wars soon escalated out of control. Freight insurance rose drastically and the Galactic Government chose not to be involved in the dispute. One of the larger space freight companies mysteriously came across several massive nuclear weapons. Shortly after the children were evacuated, the four planets in the system, Alnor, Elbi, Bartu, and Shallum Ibner were destroyed.

Telneth Star System - (Chapter 1) A star system in the Tiffan Siram Galaxy, within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Teraster - (Chapter 9) He was a dog owned by Auranaxis.

Tereen - (Chapter 10) She was a Thraxian who lived in the city of Shenix Falls on the planet Almonis Tarque. Tereen had white hair. She was good friends with Shanda Rubine.

Terrsil - (Chapter 6) He was a shuttle pilot who worked at the Yaraden spaceport.

Tharakon - (Chapter 10) He was a dignitary for the Thraxian Government. Tharakon had white hair.

Thesila Clan - (Chapter 2) One of the Notable Clans on the planet Raatoris.

Third Tiffan Siram Empire - (Chapter 2) Another name for the Galactic Government, but wasn't officially used until Boris Anathor overthrew Straton Arnious in the year 15088. The seat of the Third Tiffan Siram Empire was on the planet Ishtorb.

Third Tiffan Siram Empire Troops - (Chapter 8) Third Tiffan Siram military officers.

Thisilia - (Chapter 3) A port town on the Slave Sea on the planet Myrath.

Thorton - (Chapter 6) He was the minister of the main Universal Expanse Church on the planet Troth.

Thraxian - (Chapter 7) A species with neon blue skin that had a whitish tone. Thraxians had white hair. They had long, course organs in the back of their heads that enabled them to expand their awareness of other beings around them. The average life span of a Thraxian was four hundred years. Most of them lived on the planet Almonis Tarque.

Thraxian Government - (Chapter 9) A government ruled by the Thraxians. The seat of the Thraxian Government was on the planet Almonis Tarque. The government headquarters were in the Lysith Palace in the great city of Shenix Falls.

Tiffan Siram Empire - (Chapter 2) A reference to any of the First, Second, or Third Tiffan Siram Empires.

Tiffan Siram Galactic War - (Chapter 9) A war between the Thraxian Government, along with their Devrakian allies, and the Third Tiffan Siram Empire and Universal Expanse Church.

Tiffan Siram Galaxy - (Chapter 2) Throughout history, much of it was controlled by the Tiffan Siram Empire and Galactic Government as well as other governments, including the Thraxian Government.

Tion, Ariel - (Chapter 1) She lived in Metrocity on the planet Yaraden. Ariel lived outside of the Galactic Government's monetary system and became a harlot to survive. Later, she was able to move outside of their jurisdiction and found a clerical job in the city of Wintress on the planet Zenbat Oddnu IV. Ariel had long, dark brown hair and blue eyes.

Toris - (Chapter 8) An abandoned and forgotten planet. Approximately one third of its surface was covered by the Namaas Forest. It was formerly known as Raatoris. Toris was located within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Torra - (Chapter 1) He lived on the planet Bathannia's World. Torra was a

bald warrior. He lost a very fast fighter ship to Shane Aslat in a card game.

Troi - (Chapter 3) She lived on the planet Ponda Norax VII. Troi had long, curly, black hair. She was best friends with Shanda Rubine.

Tross - (Chapter 4) He was a business partner to Aarian on *Aarian's Freighter*. Tross was an old friend with Shane Aslat from when they both lived on the planet Bathannia's World. Shane Aslat saved Tross's life once by talking a Tarofain out of killing him.

Troth - (Chapter 3) A planet where the main Universal Expanse Church was located. Troth was home to the archives that preserved ecumenical creeds, liturgical forms, and many other religious documents. It was located outside of the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Tulli Castle - (Chapter 3) It was a structure built on Mount Amor near the old-fashioned town of Almass on the planet Myrath. The Tulli Castle was the seat of the Tulli Empire.

Tulli Empire - (Chapter 8) It was a local empire on the planet Myrath controlled by Emperor Tulli.

Tulli Realm - (Chapter 3) It was a reference to the Tulli Empire. The Tulli Realm was formed early in the colonization of Myrath. Its history began when the fierce warrior Tulli conquered the small village of Almass.

Tymor, Emperor Semadian - (Chapter 5) He was an emperor of the Second Tiffan Siram Empire from the year 14825 to the year 14843. Emperor Semadian was responsible for establishing the Galactic Economics Exchange Council (GEEC) in the year 14831.

Tyrris Militia - (Chapter 1) A space gang that was known for its renegade pirates attacks on unarmed spaceships. The Tyrris Militia raided, assaulted, and stole riches from the innocent passengers. At one point, Shane Aslat belonged to the space gang.

U

Universal Expanse Church (UEC) - (Chapter 3) It was the primary religious organization in the Tiffan Siram Galaxy. The Universal Expanse Church was formed in the year 8217 when the Kelv Wesnith Synod assembled together on the planet Troth.

Universal Expansionist - (Chapter 2) A member of the Universal Expanse Church.

W

Wintress - (Chapter 7) One of the major cities on the planet Zenbat Oddnu IV.

Wisdom Chronicles - (Chapter 8) A series of published words of wisdom by Harris Romison, one of the wisest men in history.

Y

Yaraden - (Chapter 1) An industrial planet located within the Galactic Government / Tiffan Siram Empire's jurisdiction.

Yort, Remyw - (Chapter 8) He was a legendary poet. Remyw was known for poetry that moved people.

Ythorn Asteroid Mass - (Chapter 10) A group of asteroids where a gas mining operation was located. The mining operation was destroyed during the Tiffan Siram Galactic War when the Third Tiffan Siram Empire battleship *Abbitarr* fired on the mine, causing a massive explosion that also destroyed the battleship itself, a group of Thraxian fighter pilots, and everyone inside the mining asteroid.
